Consequences

If we do not follow our rules the following will happen

- The first time –
 you will be given a warning
- The second time –
 you will be moved away from your
 friends for a time
- The third time –
 you will stay for 5 minutes after class
 with the teacher
- The fourth time –
 your teacher will telephone or talk to
 your parents
- you will see the head teacher and a letter will be sent to your parents

A really serious incident would go straight to the last step.

- feel safe and secure, both within school and in the playground.
- be protected from bullying and racism.
- have a choice

Our rules are simple and made for the benefit of the whole school community.

Rules are displayed in each classroom.

You can choose whether or not to follow our rules.

This encourages you to take responsibility for your own behaviour
