



Music and Arts

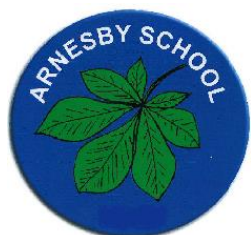
We are very proud of our Performing Arts at Arnesby. In our Village Hall we have a stage which we used for our Nativity Performance 2019 – “Wiggly Nativity”. We also love playing instruments – whether it is peripatetic lessons or percussion for a show. There is one full school performance a year in the Summer: “Jonah and the Whale” was our Summer Term Show for 2019. Each Autumn, the Years 4 - 6 take part in the Leysland Family of Schools’ Dance Festival. CLC College holds this venue in its theatre complete with sound, lighting and effects. This event is in its twenty-fifth year.

We are well known for our singing and practice at least once a week! At Christmas we often provide a school choir to the Arnesby joint church service for a very well attended Carol Concert.

Through our visit to Kingswood we also offer drumming sessions to Year 5/6 as part of their experience. These talents are showcased regularly at Music concerts e.g. Community Coffee Morning.

We also like to join with two hundred other children from Leicestershire Primary Schools to form the massed choir for the Lord Mayor’s Concert at De Montfort Hall.

We offer music clubs at different times of the year too – for example – chimes, recorders, choir, percussion.

Attendance

Please ring the school office between 08:50 and 9.20 on each day of your child's absence due to illness or use the My Child at School app.

Child Protection

The school will take any reasonable action to ensure the safety of its pupils. If police are called to a domestic violence incident they will inform the school the next working day.

Health & Safety

The school has a full Health and Safety Policy. The teachers and governors nominate a Health & Safety representative who regularly takes part in risk assessments. It is an absolute priority that a safe environment is provided for pupils, staff and visitors.

Sex Education

When the children are in Years 5/6 they are taught sensitively through a video and follow up discussion about puberty. Parents and Governors are informed of the content prior to the visit and a parent may withdraw their child from this session.

Charging Policy

The Governing Body reserves the right to make charges for educational visits and also for the cost of materials or ingredients for Art and Design. This will be worded as a voluntary contribution.
