



## **Water Safety Assembly—Drowning Prevention**



We were lucky to have an assembly recently about drowning prevention from the Everyone Active team from Wigston Pool and Fitness Centre. The children learnt "loads of different things" about how to stay safe in the summer around water. The key message was to FLOAT and that water is "colder than it looks" and onlookers should call 999 if they see anyone in the water in trouble.

Children are now aware that currents can be strong too and that you can't always see things under the water. Courage Class gave lots of examples of what they had learned and thought that the assembly was a very "helpful reminder" as it included things like locks on the canal as well as rivers and the sea, including what the different flags meant.

Please support us in getting your children in school every day and on time.


